Supplemental Information

1. Pursuant to California Code of Regulations, section 22100.2(a), a \$30 application fee is required for an applicant who is:
 - A gender-affirming health care or gender-affirming mental health care provider, employee, or volunteer;
 - A reproductive health care services provider, employee, or volunteer; or
 - A family member applying with an individual listed above. The fee applies to adults and minor children.

A \$30 application fee is not required for

 - A gender-affirming health care patient or the patient's family member; or
 - A reproductive health care services patient or the patient's family member.
2. Application payments can be made by the following methods:
 - a. Check or money order in the amount of \$30 written out to Secretary of State's Office that should be mailed with the application.
 - **Please note, this is the easiest and most secure payment method.**
 - b. Cash in the amount of \$30 that should be mailed with the application.
 - c. Credit card as indicated by handwriting at the bottom of the application "Will pay by credit card". A Safe at Home team member will call the applicant to retrieve the credit card information over the phone.
3. Pursuant to California Government Code section 6215.2(f), individuals who apply as a gender-affirming health care or gender-affirming mental health care provider, employee, or patient, or as a reproductive health care services provider, employee, or patient, will be certified for four years.
4. Volunteers providing gender-affirming health care, gender-affirming mental health care, or reproductive health care services will be certified until six months after their last date of volunteering with the facility.
